01. Requirements

- MySQL (version 5 or higher)
- MySQLi extension
- PHP (Min: version 5 or higher, Rec: version 5.3 or higher)
- Apache Mod_Rewrite Enabled
- GD Image library

02. Installation

Installation is very simple. All you need to do is edit one PHP file and import the SQL dump.

Step 1: Create a MySQL database and a MySQL user (with full permissions).

Step 2: Extract flippy_ihubs_1.0.0.zip file

Step 3: Open Flippy iHubs\ftp\new installation\db.php with your favorite text editor.

Step 4: Edit your MySQL database information and save.

Step 5: Import/execute the SQL file located in Flippy iHubs\database.

Step 6: Open Flippy iHubs\ftp\new installation folder and upload the entire content to your web server.

That's it you done installing the script.

03. Changing Administrator Username and Password

Now that you're done with the installation it's time for you to change default username and password for the administrator control panel.

Step 1: Point your browser to <http://www.yoursite.ext/admincp>

Step 2: Login using default username: admin and default password: admin

Step 3: Navigate to "Administrator" tab using the navigation menu.

Step 4: Make the desired changes.

04. Site Settings

By using site settings you can add/update site settings.

Step 1: Navigate to “Settings” using navigation menu.

Step 2: Follow the steps below to configure your site.

- Website Title – Enter your website name here
- Logo – Upload your site logo here (Please use a .PNG file 120px × 48px)
- Website URL – Enter your website URL (Without "http://" and end "/")
- Meta Description – Add your website Meta description here.
- Meta Keywords – Add your website Meta keywords here.
- Email – Your email address where users can contact you.
- Facebook App ID – See the next step (05) to learn how to setup your Facebook app ID
- Facebook Fan Page – Your Facebook fan page URL
- Twitter URL – Your twitter URL
- Pinterest URL – Your Pinterest URL
- Auto Approve Articles – If you like all new articles to automatically approve upon submission keep this setting "ON".
- Template – Chose website template.



05. Setting up Your Facebook App ID

Step 1: Point your browser to <http://developers.facebook.com/setup/>

Step 2: Login to Facebook using your Facebook account information.


Step 3: Navigate to “Apps-> Create a New App” and fill out necessary information in the popup window.

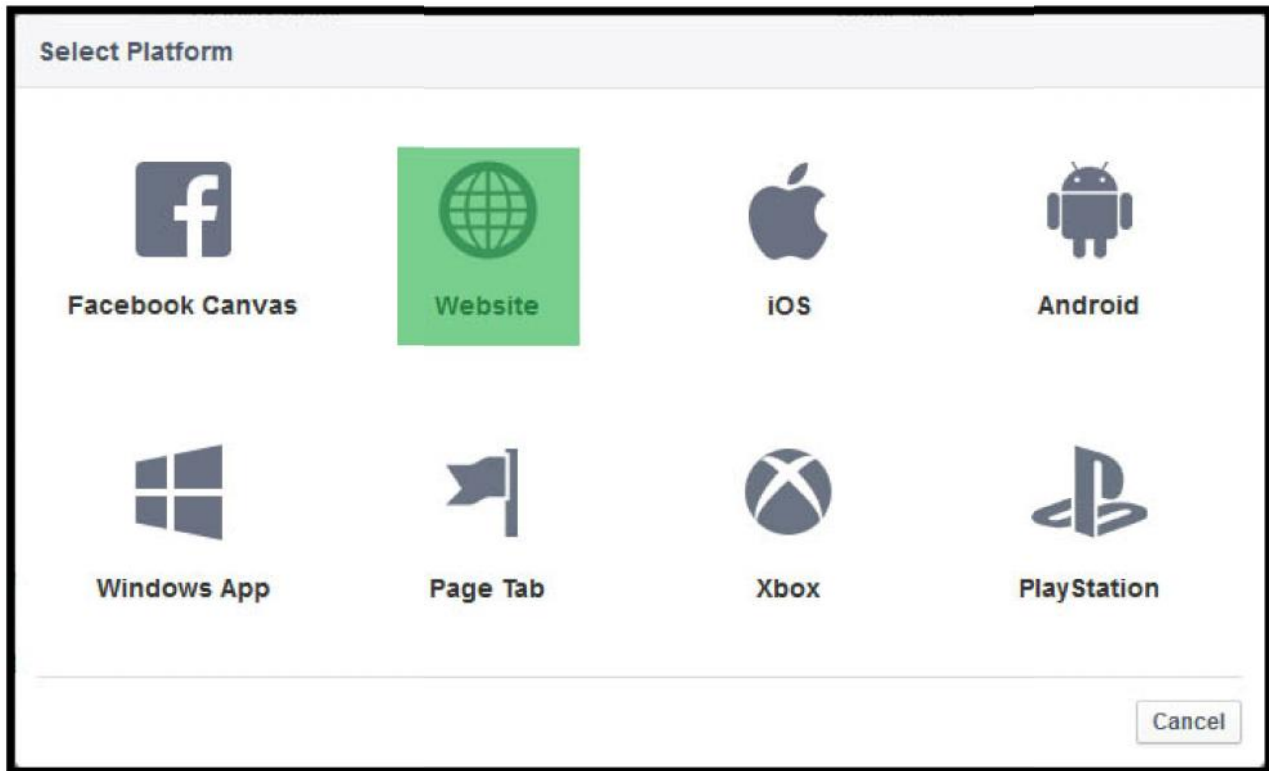
Step 3: Enter the captcha code and submit.

Step 4: Navigate to “Settings” from left side menu and click “+ Add Platform”

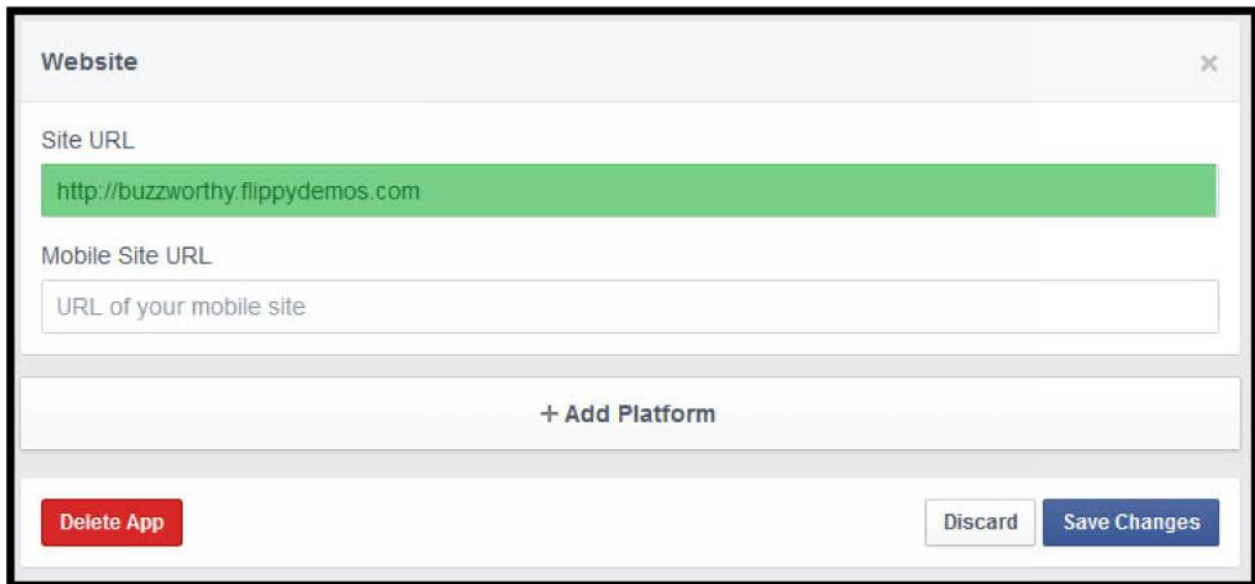

By navigating to "Dashboard" you can get a quick view of total posts, total site views, top 10 latest submits and more.

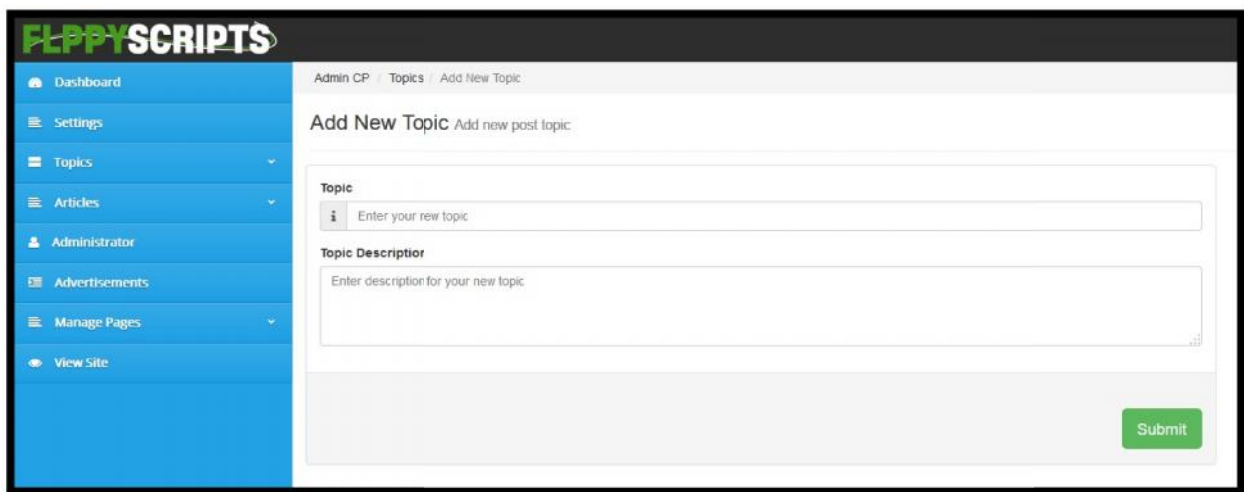
07. Add / Manage Topics & Related Topics

Add Topics:

Step 1: Navigate to "Topics -> Add New Topic" from the navigation menu.

Step 2: Enter desired topic name and topic description then click "Submit" button.



Manage Topics:

Step 1: Navigate to "Topics -> Manage Topics" from the navigation menu.


Step 2: Use "Edit" or "Delete" buttons to make the desired changes.

Important: When you delete a topic, system will also delete all the related topics & articles belong to that topic as well.

Add Related Topics:

Step 1: Navigate to "Topics -> Add New Related Topic" from the navigation menu.

Step 2: Select main topic then enter desired related topic name and related topic description then click "Submit" button.

- Use “Approve” button to approve any post.


09. Manage Approved Articles

10. Advertisements


Step 1: Navigate to “Advertisements” from the navigation menu.
